RAINBOW ROOM— In case you didn’t know or were unaware of what the Rainbow Room is and how you can support it through our congregation, here is an explanation. The Rainbow Room is a resource of the Children’s Advocacy Center. The CAC is a child-friendly place where child victims are interviewed and counseled during investigations of alleged child abuse. Among other vital services, the CAC provides necessities for children when they are removed from their homes because of abuse or neglect. Since the children often leave with just the clothes on their back, CAC keeps a Rainbow Room stocked with new clothes and other supplies like diapers, formula, etc to help these children get through a very difficult time as they are placed in foster care. Our donations make a difference to local kids in a terrible situation. You can check the bulletin or weekly e-bulletin for current needs.
